Few celebrities have enjoyed the professional longevity and personal respect of Hollywood film star Loretta Young.

Her remarkable career stretched over seven decades - from Silent Films through Hollywood's Golden Age, and on into television as host and producer of her own popular NBC series, *The Loretta Young Show*.

Along the way she appeared in 100 films, 300 TV shows, and became the first actor to win both an Academy Award and three Emmys.

She was also a noted fashion icon who earned her place as a true Hollywood legend.

But alas, today few young people even know of Loretta Young and her ground-breaking career!

It began on Miss Young's Centennial in January, 2013, at the legendary Hollywood Museum with a comprehensive, four month exhibit featuring thousands of Miss Young's personal memorabilia including; film costumes, personal clothing, furniture, advertising art, photographs and awards, including her Oscar and two of her Emmys.

It continued in March and April, 2013, when the prestigious American Film Institute mounted a Loretta Young Film Festival at the historic Silver Theatre outside Washington D.C.

The festival ran for five weeks and featured 14 of Miss Young's most popular films, including many of her rare, "pre-code" performances.



In January of 2014 a Loretta Young Centennial Birthday Tribute was staged at Glendale's lavish Alex Theatre. The evening featured live stage reenactments, film clips and personal appearances by friends and family of Miss Young who shared stories and their memories of the legendary star.



Three months later Linda & Christopher Lewis hosted a three-day, four-film Loretta Young Film Festival at the Lyric Theatre in Stuart, Florida.

In addition to movies, the festival included two VIP dinners hosted by the Lewis', a lobby exhibition of Miss Young's favorite Hollywood memorabilia and awards, and a Q&A session led by the star's son and daughter-in-law...

The Short Subject:

One-to-two hour Q&A program featuring film clips, a short documentary and special filmed appearance by Miss Young, followed by a 'talkback' with Linda & Chris.

The Cinema:

Chris & Linda introduce one of Miss Young's films... and after the screening take Q&A.

The Film Festival:

This can run multiple days and show numerous films. Chris & Linda introduce each film and take Q&A afterwards.

The first, or last program in the series could be our Short Subject program, to cap off the festival.

The Concession Stand:

As an added bonus, the Lewis' can provide 'Loretta Young' merchandise as an additional revenue stream.

Pre-Code Gold

'Wild Bill' Wellman was one of Hollywood's first and most influential directors.

One of his favorite actresses was Loretta Young, at the time one of Tinseltown's most beloved stars.

He directed her in four of his most popular films during Hollywood's Golden Age of the 1930s.
